

The Passport to Education program enables Grade 10 to 12 students to earn scholarship dollars for college, university or job training. At the end of each school year, those students who have filled in the application on the reverse showing service to the school and community, and have a history of academic success could receive scholarship credits as follows:

Grade 10 - \$250

Grade 11 - \$225

Grade 12 - \$275

If a student is successful in all three years \$750 can be put towards vocational/university/college tuition.

Passport to Education is not based solely on academic achievement. 70% is based on academics, and 30% on service to school and community, leadership quality, effort and attendance. We encourage all students to apply by completing the Passport to Education application form on the reverse of this sheet and hand in to either office by June 30th.
