Each of the following questions should be answered in a well-written paragraph or two. (10 marks each)

- 1. Disguises and mistaken identity figure prominently in Twelfth Night. Identify as many of the disguises as you can, and explain the function of each of them in the development of the plot.
- 2. Think back to the Duke's opening speech in Act I scene i. Is he praising Olivia in particular or the experience of love in general? Explain your answer by citing specific lines.
- 3. Based on his behaviour and speech in Scene I, how would you describe the Duke's character? Discuss either several specific qualities or one generalized personality trait, and why you formed the impression you did.
- 4. Relationships between the characters in Twelfth Night include real friendship, infatuation, and true love, amongst others. Describe the characters who share each of these relationships, and justify why you chose them.
