Activities based on Map 1

1. Look at the UN Development Index chart (Figure 14-1) on page 341. Neatly label the top ten countries on the blank map. Lightly shade them yellow.
2. Label the bottom ten countries on the map. Lightly shade them blue.
3. Refer to the UNDI (Figure 14-2) on page 342. Label on your map the three countries which are listed in the top ten but are not on the 1998 index (Figure 14-1).
4. Label the two countries from the bottom ten which are on the 1995 index but not on the 1998 index.

Activities based on Map 2

1. Refer to Figure 14-14 on page 350. On your map label all the HIPC's which are not in Africa. (Note: Yemen is considered part of Asia.)
2. Refer to Figure 14-16 on page 352. Label these countries on your map and shade them as follows:
 - 70-79 % – red
 - 80-89 % – green
 - 90% + – yellow

2. What is the Canadian federal government's definition of poverty?
