Passport to Education

The Passport to Education program is being phased out by the Ministry of Education and this is the last year it will be offered. **Only <u>current grade</u>** <u>12</u> students are eligible to apply this year. Grade 12 students who fill out the form and have a history of academic success could receive a scholarship credit of \$500.00.

Passport to Education is not based solely on academic achievement. 70% is based on academics and 30% on service to school and community.

An application form is being sent with this newsletter and forms are also available in the east office. Completed application forms must be handed in to the east office by June 28, 2015.

Summer Adventure Tourism Program

The Greater Victoria School District is partnering with **West Coast Adventure College** (WCAC) an amazing opportunity to explore and learn more about the growing **Adventure Tourism** sector. Running **June 29th - August 21st 2015**, this **8-week program** allows student to develop knowledge and understanding in wilderness first aid, navigation, leadership & communication skills, risk management, trip planning and survival skills.

During the first four weeks, students will be working with a WCAC instructor at **Uplands Campus** and throughout **local Victoria parks and trails**, developing their skill set through classroom and outdoor activities. During the last four weeks, students will be paired with **local tourism companies** to gain **work experience** and industry training.

Grade 11 and 12 students can apply, and will accrue 8 high school credits upon completion (Adventure Tourism 12 and Work Experience 12A). Our grade twelve students may not need the credits, but the experience and connection to local industry could be very valuable.
