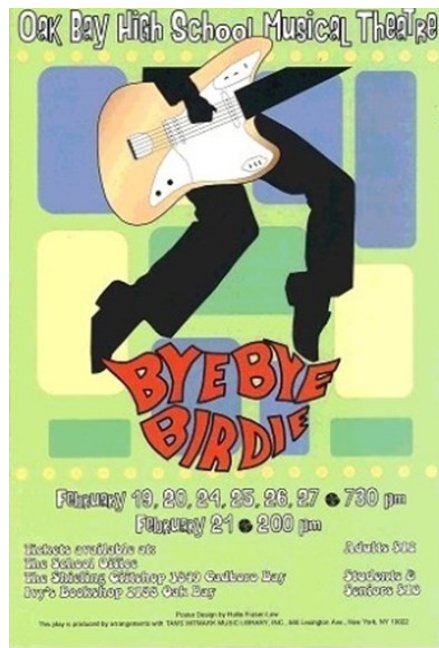
SD61 District Transfer Process

The District Transfer Process for grades K - 12 will take place between February 11th and February 19th.

Forms will be made available on the school district website for download on February 11th or they can be picked up at any school during the period of February 11th to 19th. Forms are not available before February 11th.

Completed transfer forms are to be delivered to the Board Office by February 19th at 3 pm to be considered.

Middle and Secondary Schools Change in Process: The transfer process for students in grades 8 through 12 no longer requires the secondary pathway/current principal's signature for approval.
