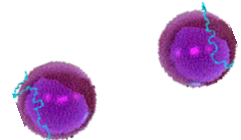

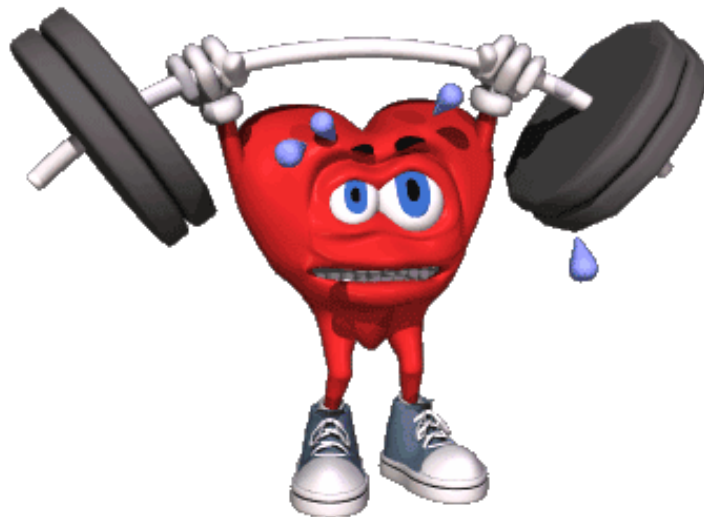

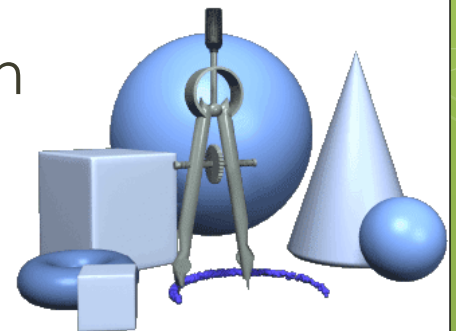

Math Selection Process

- See your grade 10 math teacher for guidance/advice.
- Discuss the teacher's guidance with your parents.
- The general guideline is that you should have earned a C+ or higher in FMPC 10 to carry on in the Pre- Calculus pathway.
- Entering a university directly from high school will mean that you will need Pre-Calc for Math and Science programs, but will likely be able to take Foundations for Humanities and some other programs.
- Remember that many colleges have math upgrading available , or math upgrading is already built into the program.

University Math Comparisons

Faculty of Humanities, Arts or Social Sciences

- Differs from school to school
- Please investigate:
 - Some require PC11
 - Some accept Foundations 11
 - Some → Found 11 and Found. 12

Faculty of Science, Business or Engineering

- All require Pre-Calculus 12
- Some require Calculus 12

General Exceptions

- English 12 and 3 other academic 12 courses
- Some universities require English 12, plus 4 other academic courses. (This is common on the east coast and Alberta)
- Comparative Civilization 12, Law 12 and Social Justice 12 are commonly accepted as academic 12 courses (Make sure you check the university web sites for the acceptance of these 3 courses)

Ace It Programs


Accelerated Credit Enrolment in Industry Training

- Ace It Electrical pathway at Oak Bay
 - Required courses at Oak Bay
 - Electrical Apprenticeship 11
 - Electrical Apprenticeship 12
 - Work Experience 12A
- Ace It Application Process in September of grade 12
 - There are 16 seats available at Camosun College on a first come first qualified basis
- Graduation in June
- Camosun College Level I Electrical July and August (tuition free if you get one of the 16 seats)

2017 Course Selection Points for grade 10's to consider

- University Sciences - require Physics 11, Chemistry 11 and two grade 12 sciences (UVic) some universities only require one grade 12 science.
- If you are interested in Biology and research - take Bio 11 or the Bio combo in grade 11. This will allow students to apply to the BC Cancer Agency Summer Internship Program between grade 11 and 12.
- UBC and SFU require a second language to grade 11.
- Nursing students – Camosun - no entry directly out of high school, B in Pre-Calc 11 or 12 or Foundations 11 or 12 (New requirements Bio 11 & 12, Chem 11 & 12)
- Nursing at UBC Okanagan -Bio 12, Chem 12, Pre-Calc 11 or Foundations 11 + another academic 12.
- Nursing schools in general - to keep doors open take Bio 11 & 12, Chem 11 & 12 and Pre-Calc 12.

- If students are headed to a US university they may want to write the PSAT in Oct of 2017. Have them see me about this so I can take their names for next fall.
- Trades - We have an Electrical Program - if students are interested they need to start in grade 11 in order to take advantage of the ACE It Program at Camosun after they graduate.
- Career Centre has many of resources: university and college view books from across Canada, career planning books. In the course selection section of our website there is a list of grade 12 academic courses that UVic and UBC will accept.

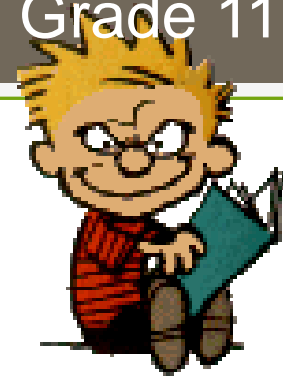

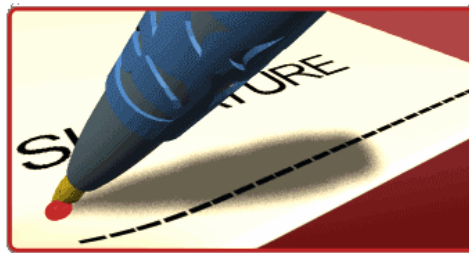
General Guidelines
