



## Math Selection Process


- See your grade 9 math teacher for guidance/advice.
- Discuss your teacher's recommendation with your parents.
- The general guideline is that you should have earned a C+ or higher to study in the "Foundations/Pre-Calculus" pathway.
- Remember that for colleges, many programs have math upgrading available for you, or math upgrading is already built into the program.


## Careers and Transitions
