Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship – Four year Tuition and Housing (US\$150,000)

Apply to become a caddie in Grade 9 or 10 at the Victoria Golf Club for the next few summers to work towards becoming an Evans Scholarship finalist for the Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship. The Evans Scholars Foundation awards full tuition and housing scholarships to high-achieving caddies with limited financial means.

To qualify, caddies must be nominated by Victoria Golf Club and meet four requirements:

- **Strong caddie record:** Applicants must have caddied, successfully and regularly, for a minimum of two years and are also expected to caddie and/or work at their sponsoring club during the summer when they apply for the scholarship.
- **Excellent academics:** Applicants must have completed their junior year of high school with above a B average in college preparatory courses and are required to take the ACT and/or SAT.
- **Demonstrated financial need:** Applicants must clearly establish their need for financial assistance.
- **Outstanding character:** Applicants must be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership.

Applicants are evaluated and compete on the above criteria for the limited number of Chick Evans Caddie Scholarships awarded annually. The Evans Scholarship Committee will interview finalists and the final selection rests with the Committee.

As a Canadian Evans Scholar you will attend the University of Washington, University of Oregon or the University of Colorado. The Evans Scholarship Foundation maintains an Evans House at each of these universities. An Evans Scholar is asked to fulfill four requirements living in an Evans House: they must maintain a strong academic record, be actively involved in house and campus affairs, respect their fellow Scholars and faithfully perform assigned house duties.
