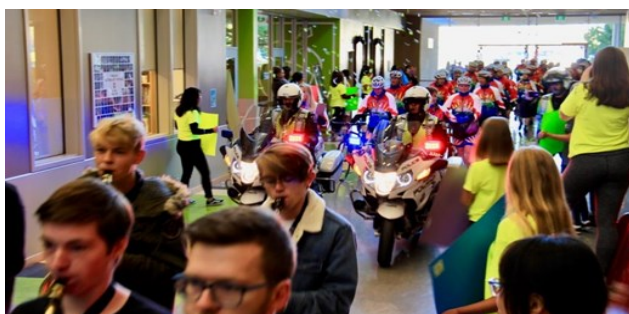
We Scare Hunger
