PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Principal Report - PAC November 27, 2017

- 1. Updates: Since our last meeting (Oct 16) we have:
 - released Interim reports to students/parents requiring some informal feedback on progress
 - requested data from teachers on our "six week check" (connections made to counsellor and administration for academic support/attendance support)
 - created a reporting system for FOCUS attendance weekly for Advisory teachers to use to schedule students for their focus times
 - created a Healthy relationships committee (several grade 12 students, 2 teachers, counsellor and principal) we are discussing respectful relationships, consent and a grade 9<->12 buddy/mentor system for girls.
 - placed 50 study carrels through the school.
- 2. Finance committee met a few weeks ago please see hard copy of discussion.
- 3. Grade 11 and 12 Curriculum updates will be draft for 2018-19 school year and will be fully in place for 2019-2020. We will be using much of the

reviewed materials - given the collaborations and time our staff have invested to this date. Grade 10 curriculum will be fully in place for 2018.

- 4. We have been so busy with the multiple sports we have at any time at our school please know we really appreciate the time and energy our parents invest in the teams they support.
- 5. Our Student Services team (Admin and counsellors) are investigating options for parent information evenings small group discussions, etc around drug use by young people. I'd like to share some ideas with PAC as we move into the New Year -

- Randi brought forward the administration team's concern regarding drug use in the school, and in particular the drug use by students in grade 9 and 10.
- Randi is asking for cooperation from parents if you hear from your student that drugs are being distributed and/or consumed *please provide names to Randi, and report these incidents to the Oak Bay police department.*
- There are reports that Xanax is being ground, mixed with fentanyl and caffeine, and then re-pressed into tablets.
- Oak Bay High School is working with Discovery Addiction Services to provide small group counselling sessions if you have any suggestions or comments related to these upcoming sessions, Randi would like to hear from you.
- Oak Bay High School Police liaison Cst. M. Lueder has made a presentation to the Grade 9 students.

 Discussion generated the following ideas for moving forward: Request Cst Lueder present to the Grade 10, 11 and 12 students. Randi will talk with the Student Services Team (Administrators and Counsellors at OBH) to determine if Cst Lueder may be brought in to do additional presentations; Increase student participation in the P.A.R.T.Y program (which at the moment is offered to students enrolled in the Oak Bay High School Planning 10 course). The P.A.R.T.Y. (Prevent Alcohol and Risk Related Trauma in Youth) Program is a dynamic, interactive injury prevention program for teenagers;

Provide the resource *iMinds* to teachers. *iMinds* is about maximizing young people's drug literacy and gambling literacy—the knowledge and skills they need to survive and thrive in a world where caffeine, tobacco, alcohol, other drug use and gambling are common. The goal is to encourage students to both express and think critically about their current drug- and gambling-related beliefs, attitudes and behaviours; Organize a symposium for parents focusing on "street drug" education; Add a weekly education component to Advisory to bring students into the conversation

and provide education;

Express our concern as parents to School District 61;

Host a screening of the documentary "Angst" – Gabriela Hirt to look into this;

Inquire at VCPAC about what other schools in our district are doing to address these issues (Kami Bourgeois to make an inquiry).
