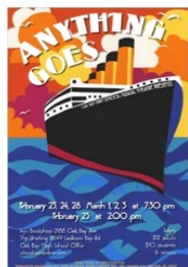
The Love-a-gram includes a Valentine's serenade by a group of three or four Choir students, a beautiful rose, two yummy chocolates and a personalized card.
