The National Association of College Admissions Counseling (NACAC) and the International Association of College Admissions Counseling (IACAC) are excited to co-host the third annual <u>Vancouver International Universities Fair</u> on **Sunday, April 29, 2018 from 1pm-4pm**. Free admission is offered to all attendees! We recommend this event to all students from Grade 9 and up. Over 100 universities from Canada, USA, UK, Switzerland, China and beyond are coming to the Vancouver Convention Centre to talk with you and your students about university options and scholarship opportunities.

If there is enough student interest we will meet at the ferry that morning and walk on the 9am ferry to Tsawwassen. A free NACAC bus will leave Tsawwassen at 10:40am and arrive at the event in downtown Vancouver at approximately 11:30am. The same bus will leave Vancouver at 4:15pm to ensure the group can catch the 6pm ferry back to Victoria.
