Thank you to the approximately 200 parents who arrived to be reunified with their child(ren) last Friday, May 11th. This reunification drill helped us to determine the improvements we would need to implement if such an evacuation was required in the future. When families are completing the Earthquake/Emergency Direction form next year, we ask that you discuss and plan with your child if you decide to check the box "Authorize the release of the student into his/her own care, if deemed appropriate by school administration." Please think about the potential traumatic scenes that may unfold if there was to be a large scale natural disaster and what your child(ren) may be exposed to if they walk themselves home. We also recommend that families attend an Emergency Planning information session offered by the community or the school district when they become available.

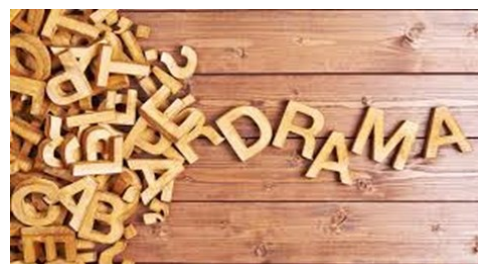
