Volunteer Driver Information

The school district policy regarding volunteer drivers requires each volunteer driver to provide to the school:

- Completed volunteer driver form (yearly)
- Copy of vehicle insurance showing minimum of \$1,000,000 liability insurance (yearly)
- Driver's abstract (every 5 years)
- Copy of Driver's license (every 5 years)
- Criminal record check (every 5 years)
