Cross Country Team at Provincial Championships

The Oak Bay cross country senior boys team won their fourth straight BC high school championship on Saturday at Beban Park in Nanaimo. Congratulations to Findlay Day (5th), Jack Boden (11th), Joe Robertson (21st), Brodie Cote (29th), Michael Barber (38th), Zach Charlesworth (60th) and Jeremy Carder (116th). A total of 30 teams and 262 runners completed the 6.2 km course.

The senior girls team won the bronze medal. Congratulations to Alisa Lyesina (4th), Delaney Chan (22nd), Sarah Bryan (37th), Ines Ciccateri (75th), Tayah Giesbrecht (100th), Jasmine Lee (104th) and Presley Rangel (120th). A total of 26 teams and 216 individuals completed the 6.2 km course.

The junior boys team finished in 10th place led by Sonny Miller in 34th.

The Oak Bay senior boys and senior girls have each won a record 12 BC high school cross country championship banners.

Vancouver Aquarium Trip: Tuesday, November 20th, 2018



Where and when are we going?

• We will be gone **all day Tuesday, November 20, 2018.** We will be meeting at Oak Bay at **5:45AM** to catch the **7:00AM** ferry, and returning home on the **5:00PM** ferry at latest. (Back to Oak Bay by 7:30 PM at latest)

What are we doing?

We will be participating in a program called Wetlab Identity. We will have the opportunity to:

- Explore local marine biodiversity and the different characteristics used to classify marine life and handle live animals.
- We will have free time in the aquarium to view exhibits such as the jellyfish, stingrays, penguins, otters, and dolphins.

Who can go?

• 6 spots remaining on the trip

How are we getting there?

- We will be taking the 7 AM Ferry to Tsawwassen from Swartz Bay
 - Meeting at Oak Bay at 5:45 AM (You take a cat nap on the ferry!)
- We will need <u>parent drivers</u> to drive between the school and the ferry terminal. If we do not get enough drivers, we will take public transit from Mayfair Mall to the ferry terminal
- Once in Vancouver, we will be taking public buses and the sky train to and from the aquarium

What is the cost?

- The total cost for the trip is \$75.00.
- This includes admission to the aquarium, the ferries, and public transit costs but not any food / drinks
