Connect to Care is a student lead group whose mandate is to start conversations about crucial topics that our youth are facing and to connect our youth to the knowledge and support services they may need.

This group will be asking students to complete a few surveys over the next couple of months. The surveys are anonymous and are NOT asking for any personal information that would lead to identifying individuals. Instead, Connect to Care is hoping to gather information about issues and the knowledge needed around such topics as healthy relationships, consent, mental wellness and harm reduction. For example, today in Advisory, students were asked to complete a survey about Consent & Sexual Assault.
