Summer Internship Program

Grade 11 Bursary for Science Students - Deeley Research Centre - Xavier Pelletier High School Internship Program is once again offering their Summer Internship Program. This program is for a student interested in cancer research and the pursuit of post-secondary education in a related field (i.e. medicine, biology, chemistry, physics etc.) The ideal candidate for the program is a team player, creative, independent, interested in lab science, excellent at problem solving and has a high maturity level. Students who apply must have a minimum overall 85% projected average in Bio. 11 or 12 and any two of math, chemistry or physics. Students awarded this opportunity will need to be available to work full time during the summer between grade 11 and 12 and upon completion will be granted a \$3000 bursary for their post-secondary education.

Oak Bay is able to nominate two grade 11 students for this opportunity. Students interested in applying must meet with Mrs. Giesbrecht in the Career Centre at lunch on Tuesday, January 22nd for details on the application process and deadlines.
