#### BC Transit Proposed Changes to Bus Routes

BC Transit is proposing to make changes to a number of local bus routes. One route change that will directly affect Oak Bay High students and staff is to the 7 UVic/Downtown bus. It currently runs between downtown and UVic on Foul Bay Road. The proposal is to move the route off Foul Bay Road and onto Richmond Avenue between Fairfield Road and Cedar Hill X Road.

BC Transit is seeking public input and feedback through open houses in the Jubilee and Burnside/Tillicum local areas for phase two of the Local Area Transit Plans **from March 11 until March 14**.

Feedback gathered through these public consultations will help BC Transit to develop recommendations to the Victoria Regional Transit Commission on how to improve existing services and identify future service needs.
