#### Measles Catch up for Students in Grades 10 to 12

Immunizations will be provided at the school for students in grades 10 to 12 on May 24<sup>th</sup>.

For those families that **received** consent forms for MMR vaccine and **have not returned** them to the school, here is some more information. (Please note that only unvaccinated or under-vaccinated students received consent forms.)

- If your child was previously immunized (outside of Vancouver Island), Public Health will not have these records on file.
- If you have immunization records for previous immunizations given elsewhere, please drop off copies at school. These can be dropped off with the consent forms. Please do this as soon as possible.
- Public Health will then input the immunization record.
- This means that updated record of immunizations will be available.
- Public Health Nurses will be at Oak Bay High on Friday, May 24<sup>th</sup> to provide MMR vaccine to those students that are eligible.

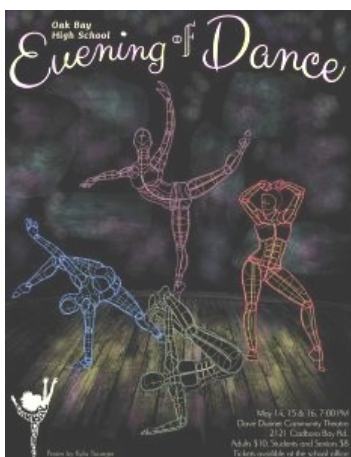
