Dear Students, Parents & Guardians,

This week's newsletter contains important information about Oak Bay High's plans for student locker cleanout, Phase 3 for June, year-end awards notification and Grad 2020 initiatives.

Phase 3

Our Health & Safety Committees has been working hard to ensure staff and students return to the building in a safe manner while meeting the guidelines set out by WorkSafeBC and therefore, we are excited for the opportunity of students returning in June in a limited capacity. Students will still continue to have the opportunity to complete their courses and work with their teachers remotely - entering the building for in-person support is completely voluntary. Teachers will communicate with each of their classes through Google Classroom outlining their June scheduled office hours where students can seek face-to-face, socially distanced support. Please reach out to the teacher if you are unsure of office hours that have been scheduled. Additionally, students can access two designated rooms to receive support and complete any outstanding assignments. The cafeteria will host students needing in-person support in Math & Science and the library will support those needing English & Socials support. Students can meet with a teacher and then move to a support space and vise versa.

We would like to plan for student attendance in these spaces as best as possible and therefore, we are asking families to notify us of their intentions. Locker Clean Out

As students return to our school on a limited basis we are asking that they take a moment to clean out their lockers. We further recognize that not all students will be coming in for additional support during these next few weeks and as such will be scheduling locker clean out for all students starting in JUNE. In an effort to control the number of students in the building at any one time, we will be asking students in **Grade/Advisory** groupings to come to the school to empty their lockers. Students must enter and exit the building ONLY through the front entrance. Hand sanitizer will be available upon entering the school as well as a large garbage bag for locker contents if required. Students will be asked to return any textbooks and other school property (for example, team uniforms) to a table set-up at the exit station. It is important that the students come ONLY at the scheduled times, again to control the overall number of students in the building at a particular time. We will be unable to store personal items left behind in lockers and as such any materials left in lockers will be collected for refuse disposal.


