Message from the Administration:

As we wind down this odd and memorable school year, we have some updates and notices to share with our Oak Bay High School families. For the past 4 weeks we have been gradually increasing the number of staff and students in our building. Over the past 2 weeks students have scheduled one-to-one or small group support from teachers in their classrooms or in our resource rooms. Typically we would have about 130 students in the building throughout the day. While this is not ideal, this has given us the opportunity to refine our health and safety protocols and plan for possible scenarios in the upcoming school year.

**Yearbook distribution:** We have been informed that Yearbooks have yet to be shipped from the publisher, due to COVID related production delays. We will alert families as soon as we have a date for delivery and our plan would be to invite students by grade/advisory to collect their books.

**Grad Regalia:** Will be released to Grade 12s on **JUNE 18**. We are hopeful that we will be able to distribute Yearbooks as well, but this may not be the case. All Grads will receive a cap and tassel, and we would therefore ask that all Grads plan to attend.
