Reminder: Literacy 10 Provincial Assessments (Nov 2-6)

Information was sent out in the [Oct 16th newsletter](#) so this is a reminder that the Literacy 10 assessment is a graduation REQUIREMENT for any student currently in grade 10 and 11. 2021 graduates (current grade 12s) do NOT have to write this assessment.
