GRADE 10 Numeracy & Literacy Provincial Assessments (January 29th, 2021)

Any grade 10 student who has taken English 10 (ie New Media 10, Creative Writing 10, Composition 10, Spoken Language 10) or Math 10 (ie Workplace 10 or Foundations of Math

and Pre-calculus 10) in quarter 1 or quarter 2 will be scheduled to write the Literacy 10 or Numeracy 10 Assessment on Friday, January 29th, 2021. It is important to note that neither of these assessments directly correlate with English 10 or Math 10 curriculum; however, we do believe that students who have successfully completed these courses will be in good standing to write these provincial assessments. Students and families will be emailed details such as time and room number in the new year.

We are fortunate to have two staff members who mark these assessments for the Ministry of Education. They have graciously given our students their time to increase student understanding of these assessments.
