# **English 10 Choices**

- Composition 10
  - Focus on writing, workplace and professional writing, research skills, formatting, and grammar
- Creative Writing 10
  - Focus on genre studies, writing and idea forming strategies, writing for purpose and audience
- New Media 10
  - Focus on technology in today's society and the increasing importance of digital media in communicating and exchanging ideas
- Spoken Language 10
  - Focus on spoken communication skills, public speaking techniques, oral poetry and storytelling, podcasting etc...

# Math 10 Choices

#### Workplace Math 10:

 provides students with math skills needed for entry into post-secondary trades and the workforce.

#### Foundations of Math & Pre-Calculus 10:

- provides students with math skills identified for post-secondary studies
- leads to either Foundations of Math 11 or Pre-Calculus 11

# **Math 10 Selection Process**

- Need help deciding? Ask your Math 9 teacher, your parents, your advisory teacher
- General guideline: C+ or higher in Math
   9 suggests the knowledge needed for
   Foundations & Pre-Calculus 10

### Science 10 <u>Discovery</u> Selection Process

- Acceptance determined by the science department based on application and teacher recommendation
- Just because you are in Discovery 9 this year, does NOT guarantee you'll be in Discovery next year
