- students with math skills needed for entry into post-secondary trades and the workforce.

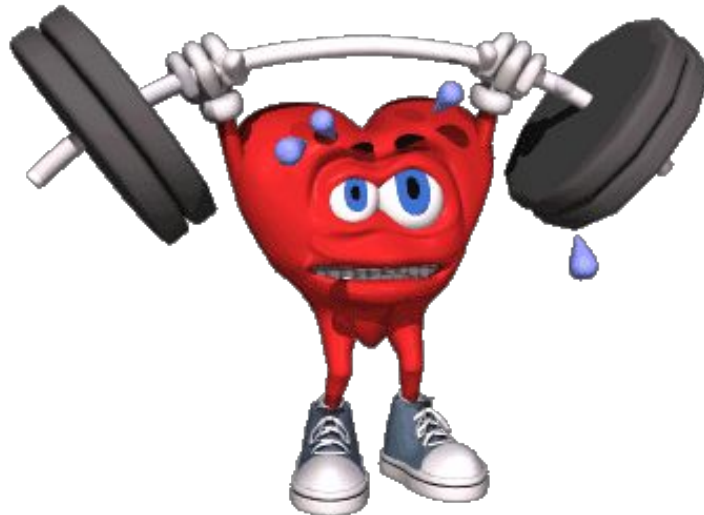
Foundations of Math 11

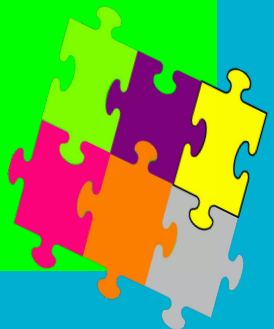

Friday Feb 5th, Mon Feb 8th and Tuesday Feb 9th


Each of those three days you will watch 2 course fair videos (6 total)
