Jr Girls BasketBall - is currently competing in the Provincial Championships. After coming into the tournament ranked #22, they upset #11 ranked Heritage Woods in the first round led by player of the game Eden Henderson. Following a close second round loss, they can still finish as high as 9th.

Jr Boys BasketBall – wrapped up their season with a 4th place finish at the Provincial Championships in Langley, their highest finish since 2006. Two players, Finnley Lillis and Toren Franklin were named Tournament all-stars.

The trip was highlighted with an amazing silver medal finish for Jeff Trumble in the Terrain GS Snowboard event, the highest individual finish for an Oak Bay athlete ever!
