Feeding Futures School Food Program Fund

This school year, the provincial government announced a new Feeding Futures School Program Fund, designed to assist schools in the development and enhancement of school meal programs and other nutritional supports for students. We know that food insecurity can be detrimental to a student's educational achievement and success and that education is a crucial social determinant of health. It is important that our students have access to food to support their educational growth and development.

We have been fortunate at Oak Bay High School to be able to provide food and snacks at school for students in the form of fresh fruit and vegetables, granola bars and other nutritious snacks. Through the new Feeding Futures fund, we are pleased to announce a partnership with Flourish! School Food Society to provide fresh and healthy meals for students in our school.

While the goal of the Feeding Futures program is to provide food to those students and families who need it, in a barrier- and stigma- free manner; we would also like to offer lunches to other students who wish to purchase a healthy and home-cooked lunch.

A free breakfast offering will be available for students starting next week. Beginning at 8:40 am, grab and go snacks will be available outside the office.

Lunch Program

In January, we are starting a lunch program for students that will be available everyday. Our primary goal will be to provide food for those students who need it cost free. As we get the program up and running, hot lunches will be available to all students for purchase.
