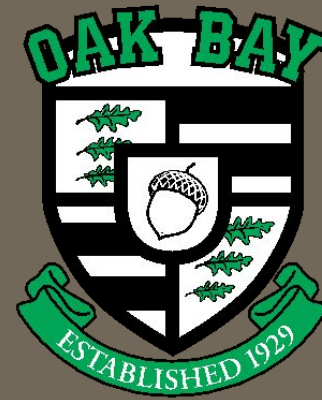

 - Literacy 10
 - Literacy 12
 - FRAL 12 (French Immersion)

Grade 12 Requirements

English

- 2 mandatory courses:
 - English Studies 12 or English First Peoples 12
 - CLC 12 (outside TT)
- + 3 level 12 courses

French Immersion

- 3 mandatory courses:
 - English Studies 12 or English First Peoples 12
 - CLC 12 (outside TT)
 - Français Langue 12
- + 2 level 12 courses

At least 3 *electives* MUST be at the Grade 12 level.

Grade 12 Requirements

Indigenous-Focused Graduation Requirement

- You need a minimum of 1 class (4 credits)
- First Peoples English 11
- First Peoples English 12
- BC First Peoples 12 (Social Studies)
- Études Autochtones Contemporaines 12
(*French Immersion grade 11/12*)


General Guidelines



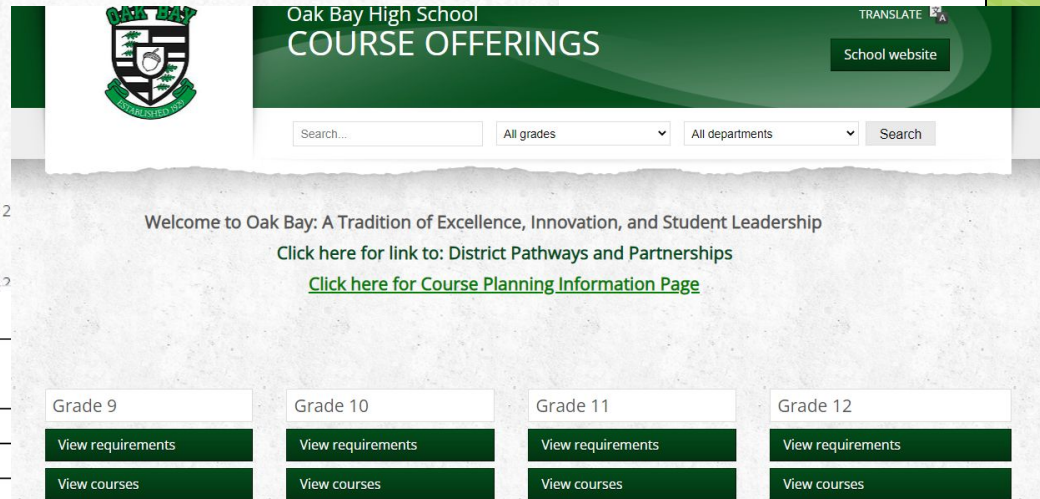
