- School population is down to 1347 students.

 - There were 120 international students for the 2023/24 school year. The number of international students for the 2024/25 school year is 40.
 - Funded student numbers (international): 25-35% may not be renewed,
 resulting in lower enrollment numbers.

- Speed of email from the admin was appreciated.
- Culture of gathering in washrooms especially in boys bathroom vaping
 - o Girls eat lunch in stalls in groups, or just hang out on their phones
 - Some kids are afraid to use the bathrooms.
 - Cost don't want to penalize the majority of kids for a few instigators
- District office and board decides about cameras in victoria schools
 - Safety and privacy are both concerns
- Staff are Identifying and trying to alleviate problematic behaviours
- Vape detectors tried in other districts but not here
