Bowker Creek Blueprint 2.0 - A 100-Year Action Plan to Restore the Bowker Creek Watershed

The Bowker Creek Blueprint is a detailed 100-year action plan to revitalize the Bowker Creek watershed. This includes improvements to the creek, habitat and community like freeing Bowker Creek from underground pipes and inviting fish back into the creek.

It is now time to update the Blueprint and revise actions based on accomplishments, new information and current pressures facing the watershed. The updated Blueprint will continue to guide the municipalities, the community, and other land stewards to manage and restore the watershed and creek corridor into the future.
