Student Learning Surveys (Until May)

Students (and parents) in grade 10, 11, and 12 across the province have the opportunity to give feedback on their educational experience through Student Learning Surveys from the BC Ministry of Education. The purpose of the Student Learning Survey is to gather information that will influence curriculum changes, learning environment, student wellness and satisfaction, student belonging and engagement, and career preparation.

Students will be provided an opportunity to complete these surveys at school during advisory time in the first week of February, and then online until May 1, 2026.
