Hot Lunch Program

If you prefer to only buy a card for a smaller number (ex. 5 lunches), you can also see the accounts clerk, in the main office, with cash or card. Finally, you are always able to come to the line and pay with cash (and now card) if you prefer (\$6 + transaction fee).

Student Parking & Drop Off

Parking is a real challenge for our school community. With a large school staff we require that students who bring a vehicle to school that they do not park in the staff parking lots -these include the lot at the front of the school and the lot behind the school near the gymnasiums. Student parking is the lot immediately off of Cranmore St. before the bus enclosure.

With respect to student drop-off, in order to best ensure the safety of all of us, we ask that student drop-offs take place at the front of the school where folks can drive in and out through the one-way drive through area. Please **do not use the back of the school** as it creates too much congestion.

Students Arriving Late to Class

As our students are now back into the routine of school we ask that you support us in doing everything possible to help ensure students get to school, on time, and prepared for the day. A challenge we continually face, particularly first thing in the morning and again right after lunch, is students arriving late to class.
